Winter weather can come early and change quickly in Wisconsin. When winter weather is upon us, we have three options for adjusting our school days.

 Cancellation- If we cancel school, the decision will be made by 6:00am. This means CLS and all after school lessons or programs along with public use of the building are cancelled for the day.
Two Hour Delay- If we delay, the decision will be made by 6:00am. The school days starts at 9:45am, two hours later than normally scheduled. Busses run two hours behind their normal schedule and school lunch will be served at or near the normally scheduled time. After school lessons and programs along with public use of the building may still occur. If a two hour delay becomes a cancellation, that decision will be made by 8:00am.

3. Early Release- If we release early, school will release at 11:50am and students will follow their normal afternoon transportation plan unless you notify the school of a change or have notified the school through the registration form filled out.

Lunch will be served at or near the normally scheduled time. After school lessons and programs along with public use of building is cancelled.

CLS plans to communicate any weather-related decisions in the following ways: all school text messaging and local TV and radio (on TV and radio, if Chippewa Falls schools close, Christ Lutheran School is also closed. We follow the Chippewa Falls guidance due to bus transportation).

Also, we do attempt to have students outside for recess daily unless the temperature is below zero or there is precipitation. Please send appropriate outdoor clothing with your child for the weather.
