Thank you for choosing Christ Lutheran School with the responsibility of educating your child. We are thankful for each of our students. February 1<sup>st</sup> is the beginning of our enrollment period for the 2024/2025 school year. We are looking forward to continuing our commitment to provide an excellent education for your child in the coming year.

Tuition rates have been set and approved for the 2024/2025 school year. Our goal is to keep tuition increases as reasonable as possible. We work to balance the financial demands on our families with the goal of providing a quality education for your children. The school board did vote to raise the tuition costs for the coming year with the focus on raising teacher salaries. We are blessed at Christ Lutheran School with an amazing staff and we would like to retain the staff and pay them a fair salary along with considering inflation rates as well.

The tuition increase for this coming school year is between \$16-\$27 per month per child. This increase was voted on and approved by the school board to continue to support our valuable teaching staff.

There are opportunities to reduce your tuition costs by taking on extra cleaning spots each week and/or purchasing scrip through our scrip program.

As enrollment opens on February 1<sup>st</sup>, please visit the school website at <https://www.christluthेरanschool.org/admissions> to enroll your child for the 2024/2025 school year. Scroll down and click on “**2024/2025 enrollment application**” when enrolling. Current students enrolled at CLS get first placement if forms have been filled out online by March 1<sup>st</sup>. There is a limited number of students accepted in each class and with the increase of enrollments, please know that some classes may fill up quickly.
